There is a warehouse full of brand new clothing, essential supplies, diapers, wipes, and so much more to aid the families in their immediate need. Once the families receive a call for a child's placement they have the liberty to come and stock up on supplies for the children. The association also provides scholarships and occasional outreaches to bless the children and their families.

Formerly Child Care Links and Family Service Counseling and Community Resource Center, Hively provides children and families throughout Alameda County access to high-quality social services. Additional services include:

- **EDUCATION:** Workshops are offered to parents, family members, child care providers and the community. Click [here](#) to see the upcoming schedule that includes coaching, interactive STEM workshops, health and safety training, and trauma informed care.

- CHILD CARE: Our family support specialists can help parents find and pay for child care through our child care alternative payment programs throughout Alameda County. Contact us to find out if you're eligible to receive financial assistance for child care.
- MENTAL HEALTH: With more than 20 dedicated therapists on staff, Hively provides affordable (sliding scale), high quality, professional counseling services for a variety of challenges affecting the emotional health and wellbeing of individuals, young and old, and their families. Hively clinicians are experienced Clinical Social Workers (CSW) and Marriage and Family Therapists (MFT). Individual, group, family and couples therapy is available. Accept most major insurances, and Medi-cal.
- DIAPERS: The Hively Diaper Pantry provides low-income families with a one-month supply of diapers and diaper wipes. In addition, each family goes home with a children's book and educational materials to support not only healthy bee-hinds, but healthy minds, too. Join us at our Pleasanton location on Tuesdays and Thursdays between 9am–5pm. Please bring a valid I.D. with you!
- COMMUNITY CLOSET: Hively provides new and gently-used clothing, shoes, books, home goods, and furniture—free of charge—to families in need. Families can shop at the store front (7066 Village Parkway, Dublin) by appointment only.
- DAD & ME PROGRAM: Starting this fall, Hively will be offering a recreational program to strengthen the bonds between kids and their dads. If you're interested, send us an email at dadandme@behively.org.
- CHILD WATCH: Hively offers contracts with business and organizations to offer child watch services when parents are in workshops, trainings, or meetings.
- CAR SEAT SAFETY CHECKS: Hively provides car seat installation instruction by Certified Car Seat Safety Technicians. Guided instruction will offer parents hands-on experience on the proper installation of child safety seats.
- PLAY GROUPS: Hively offers regular play groups for babies and toddlers ages 0-3 years old. Parents and caregivers have the opportunity to meet other parents while children can engage and explore with hands-on learning experiences and social interaction.
