PUSD FREE BREAKFAST + LUNCHES

CALFRESH

CalFresh is the new name for California's Food Stamp Program. CalFresh is a Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) that provides assistance for households to purchase nutritious food. The program uses an easy credit card format called Electronic Benefit Transfer (EBT) to purchase food at retail stores and farmers markets. Alameda County Food bank offers services in Spanish, Vietnamese, Cantonese, Mandarin.

Who May Be Eligible

- All US citizens (Except persons receiving SSI/SSP benefits)
- Most immigrants Legal Permanent Residents

***Due to coronavirus (COVID 19), children who are eligible for free or reduced-price meals at school will get extra food benefits. These food benefits are called **Pandemic EBT** or P-EBT benefits. P-EBT benefits help families in California buy food when school is closed. If you have a question about the P-EBT, you can complete this form.
